Functions, procedures, practices, policies, and past history will be explained to assist the new board member assume their leadership roles

and responsibilities.

The orientation of new board members shall include the following:

- An individual meeting with the District Administrator to include building

and staff orientation

- An individual meeting with the Board President

- And a joint meeting with the District Administrator and Board President

In addition, new board members shall receive the following:

- Materials that detail board member powers, duties, limitations, role, and

legal responsibilities

- Introduction to the school websites containing school Board policies,

District news, school email, annual calendar, etc.

- Materials pertinent to meetings and other required information

- A copy of the Wisconsin Open Meetings Law Compliance Guide

- Encouragement to attend WASB seminars, meetings, and conferences
