

443.4 - USE OR POSSESSION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

Drinking or possession of alcoholic beverages by students on school property or at any school function under supervision of school authority, whether it is on or off school campus, is forbidden.

No student who has had an alcoholic beverage to drink may come to any function of the school. Evidence of consumption of alcoholic beverages is sufficient reason to be denied permission to attend classes or school sponsored events. Students may also be detained pending notification of parents and law enforcement authorities. The consequences for such action starts with a three day suspension from school, a student and parent meeting with a committee made up of the principal and administrator prior to re-admittance. Subsequent offenses will result in an automatic referral to the School Board for expulsion.
