Veterans Coffee Club

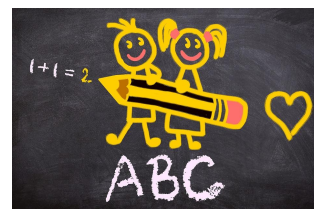

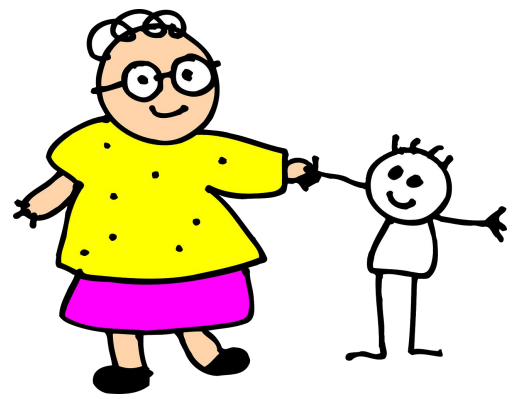
