### Auburndale Students Participate in District Solo & Ensemble Festival

WAUNAKEE, Wis. (January 29, 2019) – Students from area schools will participate in a Wisconsin School Music Association (WSMA) sanctioned District Solo & Ensemble Music Festival hosted at Auburndale High School on Friday, February 15, 2019. During the festival, which is free and open to the public, Auburndale students will perform in 109 vocal and instrumental solos, duets, trios and small ensembles before an adjudicator.

WSMA music festivals annually attract thousands of students from middle, junior high and high schools throughout Wisconsin. The festival will draw students from a number of area schools, including Assumption High School, Assumption Middle School, Auburndale High School, Auburndale Junior High School, Columbus Catholic High School, Columbus Catholic Middle School, Newman Catholic High School and Newman Catholic Middle School. Jennifer Nueske, music director from Auburndale High School, will be serving as the festival manager.

Our long-standing festival programs encourage well-rounded musicians who develop deeper understanding through performance preparation that culminates in comprehensive feedback from a qualified adjudicator. 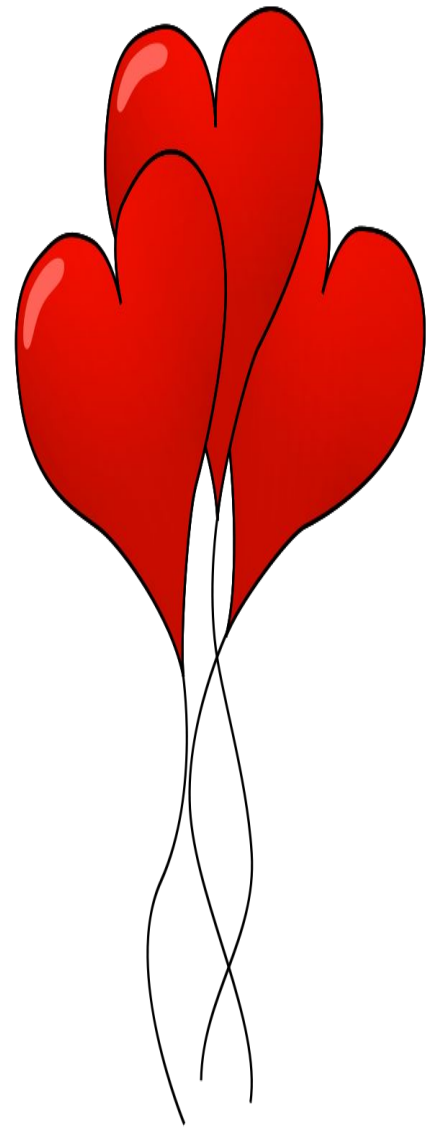
