Time: 12:15-1:45 for boys entering 4th-6th grades in the 2019-2020 school year.

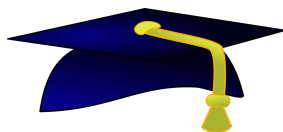
2:00-3:30 for boys entering 7th-9th grades in the 2019-2020 school year.
