



After more than a year of study, planning, and community engagement, the School District of Auburndale Board of Education has placed two referendum questions on the November 3rd ballot.

Question 1 seeks \$200,000 in recurring operating funding to partially replace \$400,000 in operational revenue expiring in 2021. If approved, the operational funding will be used to invest in technology and maintain quality staff.

Question 2 seeks \$6.9 million facilities upgrades including:

- Invest in infrastructure projects such a roof and window replacements, building system upgrades and parking lot repairs, and;
- Expand and renovate the technical, agricultural and family & consumer education classrooms at the middle / high school, providing increased access to hand-on learning experiences.

If passed, the two referendum questions carry an estimated combined maximum tax impact of \$36 per \$100,000 of property value. The School District of Auburndale currently has the lowest tax rate in the area.
