## Updated COVID Guidelines for The School District of Auburndale January 5, 2022

Good Afternoon District Families,

As you may know, the CDC has updated it's guidelines for quarantine and isolation due to exposure to the COVID 19 virus. Wood County has followed these guidelines for our county schools. I wanted to let you know of these changes right away. Detailed updates will be sent by your student's school office when appropriate but the basic changes affect the length and impact of quarantines and isolation as follows;

- All students/staff who have tested positive will quarantine for 5 days after symptom onset or 5 days after being tested if they do not have symptoms and will be allowed to return to school and school activities on days 6-10 with a mask.
- All unvaccinated close contacts of a person who has tested positive must quarantine for 5 days from last exposure and will be allowed to fully return to school and school activities on days 6-10 with a mask.
- All fully vaccinated close contacts will not need to quarantine, as long as they do not develop symptoms, a mask will be worn through day 10, and they should monitor for symptoms.
- All symptomatic students/staff who do not test will quarantine for 5 days and return on days 6-10 with a mask if symptoms are resolving and, as always, fever free.

\* Wood County follows the current guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) which considers the following individuals fully vaccinated with no quarantine requirement:

Adults: 1) received a primary COVID-19 series AND a booster; OR 2) completed primary series of Pfizer or Moderna within the last 6 months; OR 3) completed primary series of J&J vaccine within the last 2 months.

Under 18 years old: 1) received a primary COVID-19 series OR 2) completed primary series of Pfizer or Moderna within the last 6 months; OR 3) completed primary series of J&J vaccine within the last 2 months
