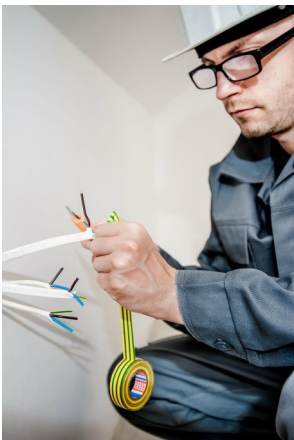


OUR MISSION

Employer Responsibility

1-2-3

Allow our students to shadow a **minimum** of:

- 1 hour per day for up to
- 2 days per week for as long as
- 3 consecutive weeks
- Provide an overview of the requirements, expectations, and routines associated with the position/ career field they are interested in.

Student Responsibility

Students are responsible for:

- Contacting the business to set up the job shadowing placement and scheduling
- Providing their own transportation
- Showing up on time and when scheduled
- Maintaining passing grades in all courses to participate in this program

This program will begin September 2024, and will be part of our required personal finance class.

We're looking for employers who embody these qualities..

- Located within 20 miles of Auburndale
- Have team members who are willing to provide 1-on-1 shadowing
- Want to be an integral part of influencing young adults in their post-graduation plans by exposing them to potential future careers
- Want to provide real work experience to future potential candidates and grow your own work force once students graduate
- Provide as much "real life" job expectations without exposing students to safety, health, or sensitive conditions that may be part of the career experience.
